Ministries must be funded to carry out our mission and vision and to provide day-to-day contact with the wider community. Growth in both members and vitality continue to be very high priorities.

Your generosity is crucial to sustaining our commitment to our community and our world.

As cheerful givers, we do not give to a budget. We give to God with hearts filled with thanksgiving and gratitude. God challenges us to surprise ourselves by abundant generosity. By returning a portion of our monetary possessions to God,

we allow God's love to flow more freely in our lives and fully live into our call to be disciples of Christ.

Our tradition, flowing down through the teachings of Jesus, has given us an essential way to develop our response to gratitude by giving back a portion of what we have been given as a way of acknowledging and expressing gratitude for all we have received in this life. Prayerfully consider what your commitment of gratitude will be this year. Pledging to St. Bart's not only helps us to sustain our rich and varied community, it keeps us together, growing us as a community of faith.



WAYS TO CONSIDER YOUR 2023 PLEDGE

Maintain

At the very least, keep our present momentum going by maintaining your present pledge. Remember to add an inflationary or cost-of-living increase (approximately 8%) so that your dollars have the same purchasing power to offset expenses incurred by the parish to carry out our mission and ministry. It takes more financial resources each year to simply maintain.

Incremental Increase

Whatever you gave last year, consider increasing it by 10%. For example, if you gave \$1,000 in 2022, then give \$1,100 for 2023. If everyone increased their pledge by 10% for 2023, then not only would our resources increase, but we would be able to begin shifting the ways we use our endowed and reserve funds to support ministry development.

Proportional Giving

Proportional giving recognizes that giving back to God is a journey and that tithing is a level of giving to aspire to. It requires us to make a conscious effort to determine an appropriate level of giving for today, and then to be open to allowing our giving to grow in the future. The Proportional Giving Chart below might be helpful. Consider increasing your pledge by one percent of your income each year. This practice of giving has the power to transform lives and shape the souls of many.

Joy-filled Worship



Building & Equipping a Community Ready to Serve



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT IS A PLEDGE?

A pledge is simply an estimate of what you expect to give to the church to support its mission and ministry in the year to come. This enables us to plan our budget and make careful, purposeful decisions. On a personal level, pledging helps transform your giving into a spiritual practice, because it becomes something you do regularly like worship or prayer. By transforming our giving in a commitment, we reinforce for ourselves that God is a priority in our life.

WHAT DOES THE OPERATING **BUDGET SUPPORT?**

The operating budget of the church supports our mission and ministry including pastoral care, worship and liturgy, administration and Christian formation.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

Just as you do with your household budget, St. Bart's calculates how much it costs to run the church for a typical week. That weekly cost comes out to about \$23,897 including:

\$4.869 **Pastoral Care** & Worship

\$4.308 **Building & Grounds**

\$4,419

& Programs

\$3,037 Inspirational Music **Christian Formation** Program

HOW MUCH SHOULD I PLEDGE? WHAT IS A TITHE?

The tithe is best understood in the context of giving from our 'first fruits,' which is to give our incomefirst in. first out-rather than from what's left over. One standard that Christians have used for giving from your 'first fruits' is the tithe-giving 10% of our income right off the top. If you don't feel ready for that level of giving, start with a 5% modern tithe or proportional giving and work toward increasing it each year with a spirit of gratitude.

HOW DO I PAY MY PLEDGE?

Your pledge may be paid at the frequency of your choice (weekly, monthly, quarterly or annually) by check, credit card, appreciated securities or tax-free IRA distributions if you meet certain age requirements. Please know that all conversations are confidential and pastoral support is available if needed.

WHAT IF I PUT MONEY IN THE OFFERING PLATE? DOES THAT TAKE THE PLACE OF A PLEDGE?

Putting money in the offering plate at weekly services is a good spiritual discipline that does not take the place of a pledge. Plate offerings are contributions that we are unable to financially plan for in support of our mission and budget. During special weekend services throughout the year, plate offerings support outside ministry efforts.
